## DATA PROTECTION ACT – General Data Protection Regulations 2018 (GPDR)

You maybe aware of the new General Data Protection Act which enforces new guidelines and regulations for data handling. As a member of the Barton on Humber Gundog Club as an annually paid member your personal details are retained by ourselves on our database and therefore we have to comply with the new laws which have come into force May 2018.

How the club will ensure that we are GPDR compliant:

1. Your privacy of information  
We retain your name, address, telephone numbers, email address, dog breed preferences, activity preferences and kennel club affix name. We only keep this information with the clubs secretary and this is never shared other than with the clubs appointed committee if and when required. We do not store any member detail on Cloud or Dropbox or any other online storage system.
2. Consent to use your personal data  
Your personal information is never sent to other third parties and is only shared if and when required by the secretary to other appointed committee members.  
Your name and address will however go once a year in the form of a printed label to a printers of the clubs choosing prior to the Trial schedule and AGM notice being printed and then being posted out to you.  
Once a year the Kennel Club require Annual Returns from all clubs however the information they require is only a total number of members not their personal details.
3. Applications, Draws and Running Cards for Trials  
As a club member you will be required to enter your details and that of your dogs on an application form prior to entering any of the clubs trials. This information will be retained at the secretaries home along with all that years relevant paperwork to satisfy rules of running a Gundog Club. This information will be kept as secure as is possible and will not be shared with third parties.  
If you have entered a trial your name will be put onto the club web site immediately after a trial draw has taken place when the secretary posts the information for members.  
If you are successful in running your dog in one of the trials once again the club uses your information to form the running card for that trial. This information is available to anyone attending the trial on the day and afterwards a copy will be retained with the applications forms for that trial. A copy of this is required to be sent to the Kennel Club but no other third parties will get a copy.

The club will endeavor to comply and protect effectively and welcome any comments a member may have however

**RULES, REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION  
FOR BOHGC TRIALS**

The Trials will be run under Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations.

Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.

All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the competitor.

If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by a draw.

Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.

No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.

Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.

In case of withdrawals regulation J7f applies at all times.

Substitutions of dogs will be allowed only if dog has required qualifications.

If paying by cheque a separate cheque for EACH ENTRY is required.

All trophies to be held for one year and engraved at the winner's expense. Returning back to the club secretary is also the responsibility of the winner and the committee would stress we recommend a proof of postage receipt be purchased.

**WELFARE OF DOGS**

A competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

**DEFINITIONS OF STAKES**

**Open**

A Stake in which dogs have the opportunity of gaining a qualification towards the title of Field Trial Champion (K Regulations refer) and towards entry in the Championship or Champion Stake for its breed; in which entry is open to all dogs of a specified breed or breeds except that such Stakes may not be confined to Any Variety Spaniel [except Spaniel (English Springer) and Spaniel (Cocker)]. It may be limited to a prescribed number of runners (J4 refers), in which case these shall be decided by a draw conducted in accordance with Regulation J7.i. so that preference is given to previous performance.

**All Aged**

A Stake which is open to all dogs of a specified breed or breeds without restriction as to their age, but which may be restricted by any other conditions which may be determined by the society subject to the approval of the General Committee of the Kennel Club.

**Novice**

Retrievers, Spaniels and Breeds which Hunt, Point and Retrieve: A Stake which is confined to dogs which have not gained a place which would qualify them for first preference in the draw for Open Stakes. Pointers and Setters: A Stake which is confined to dogs which have not gained a First, Second or Third in Open Stakes or First or two Seconds in All Aged, Novice or Puppy Stakes prior to the close of entries.

**Puppy.**

A Stake which is confined to dogs under the age of two years at the scheduled date of the Stake.

The club also politely request that

.....all competitors please adhere to a smart dress code and also if they have been put out of the trial that they stay if at all possible until the end to be part of the thankyou's and prize giving. If a runner cannot help but leave they must come and tell the bohgc secretary at the trial and hand in their arm bands and again if possible thank the judges before walking from line.

..... all competitors, helpers, judges, and visitor's to the trial please switch off their mobile phones once the trial is about to commence. Also that all dog waste be picked up and taken home please and not left at the venue of the trial.

.....Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the Chief Steward and the host.
